KEY WORK IN THE **2022-23 B:CIVIC YEAR**

Working with our partners, we:

- Grew the **B:CIVIC community** to 132 investors representing nonprofits, foundations and corporate businesses.
- Hosted the largest hybrid Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and Environmental Social Governance (ESG) conference in the region, the **2022 B:CIVIC Summit | Turning Point**, with 370 attendees from 207 organizations.
- Hosted our **first community dinner** with Longer Tables to build meaningful connections.
- Developed resources, including a **Mental Health and Well-being Toolkit**, three small business spotlights and six case studies on best practices.
- Launched the first **State of the CSR and ESG Profession in Colorado** survey to benchmark and increase transparency of the profession.
- Honored 50 companies through **The Civic 50 Colorado**, recognizing almost \$80 million in monetary and in-kind donations to Colorado charitable causes and more than 230,000 volunteer hours.
- Expanded the **advisory board of directors** by 8 members deepening our expertise in ESG and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI).
- Provided **two scholarships** to participants for the University of Colorado Leeds School of Business Certification in ESG Strategy.
